

Quiz 7- Encouraging mobility

PURPOSE

- Mobility is very gratifying for the participant's organisation. It opens up their minds to other cultures, other languages and of course to the European dimension.
- Each time one member of an organisation goes on a mobility the entire community will have feed-back when he comes back. The whole organisation benefits from individual mobility.
- Because it is a real opportunity for a participant to improve his knowledge, skills and his perception of the European dimension.

BEFORE MOBILITY

- The future participant must collect information about his own personal, regional and national environment (all types of documents). He will be a sort of ambassador in a new country.
- The future participant should gather information about the country he will visit.
- The future participant must anticipate the expectations of his future hosts.

DURING MOBILITY




- Participants should keep in touch with their fellows at home.
- Regular meetings between hosting organisation's learners and mobility participants should be organized.
- Each participant should write a personal travel log.

EVALUATION




- Participants should be evaluated by specialists after returning from mobility.
- Participants should practice self-evaluation.
- Participants should be evaluated by their hosting organisation all along the period of mobility.



SELECTION OF PERSONS FOR MOBILITY

-  The individuals with the greatest needs to improve some specific skills.
-  The most representative members of the sending institution.
-  The individuals most involved in the project.

Now find out how good you are at encouraging mobility!

- Mostly**  Your approach of mobility focuses on the participant of the mobility. You should also take into account the learners who will not have the opportunity to travel.
- Mostly**  You consider mobility as a means for the hosting learners to improve their knowledge about the culture of the mobility participant. You should also focus on the other learners, both those who participate in mobility and those who stay at home.
- Mostly**  You consider mobility mostly as an opportunity for the sending organisation's learners to travel mentally as they benefit from the feed-back of the mobility participant. You should also focus on the participant of the mobility.
